

Certification Regarding the Release of Controlled Technology or Technical Data to Foreign Persons in the U.S. in H-1B or O-1 Status

Federal regulations require that employers certify that they have reviewed the **Export Administration Regulations (EAR)** and the **International Traffic in Arms (ITAR)** and have determined whether a license is required from the U.S. Department of Commerce or the U.S. Department of State to allow an employee access to controlled technology. Technology and technical data provided to a foreign national within the U.S. is considered an export. ***This attestation is REQUIRED for all H-1B petitions and O-1 petitions.***

The hiring supervisor, principal investigator, Department Chair, or other appropriate University authority responsible for oversight of an employee's work and access to technology, must attest to one of the following two statements in order for the ISSO to process the H-1B or O-1 petition.

Please understand that a license may be required. Questions should be directed to the Office of Research Compliance and Training or the Office of General Counsel, after a thorough review of the information published on the website.
