

## Estimated Tuition, Fees, and Living Expenses for the Academic Year College of Dental Medicine

Students admitted to schools at the Columbia University Irving Medical Center must submit their Certificate of Eligibility Application (I-20) and required supporting documents to the ISSO - CUIMC office. The I-20 form will be issued by the ISSO - CUIMC campus.

- If you are married and plan to bring your spouse or children, you must document additional funds for your dependents. The amounts for the Academic Year are \$1,000 per month for your spouse and \$500 per month for each child. Your dependents may join you at any time during your program of study.
- Summer tuition and fees are required for certain programs of study.
- Students can expect tuition and fees to increase approximately 3-5% annually.
