



Notice of the Filing of a Labor Condition Application with the Employment and Training Administration

1. An H-1B non-immigrant worker is being sought by Brown University through the filing of a Labor Condition Application with the Employment and Training Administration of the U.S. Department of Labor.
2. One such worker is being sought.
3. The occupation classification for which the work is being sought is "Philosophy and Religion Teachers, Postsecondary"
4. An annual salary of ninety-nine thousand seven hundred and twenty-two dollars is being offered to this worker.
5. The period of employment for which this worker is sought is September 1, 2026 to October 31, 2029.
6. The employment will take place at Brown University, Department of Philosophy, 45 Prospect Street, Providence RI 02912 and at Columbia University, Department of Philosophy, 1150 Amsterdam Avenue, 708 Philosophy Hall, New York NY 10027.
7. The Labor Condition Application will be available for public inspection at Brown University, 69 Brown Street, Suite 420, Providence, RI 02912.
